MINUTES: Councilwoman Cindy Gray motioned to approve the regular meeting minutes from 05/24/23 and special meeting minutes from 05/31/23. Councilman Bill Abbott seconded the motion. *Motion carried*.

<u>CLAIM APPROVALS</u>: Councilwoman Cindy Gray moved to approve the claims/bills presented for June 2023. It was seconded by Councilman Bill Abbott. *Motion carried*.

<u>MAINTENANCE REPORT</u>: Mayor Corr provided an update to the council regarding the repaired leak at Cedar Mill. He also informed that the maintenance crew has resumed street sweeping activities in response to the recent wind storm, which caused significant debris accumulation. In addition, preparations for Troy Days are underway, with plans to paint the streets within the next week.

<u>CODE ENFORCEMENT REPORT</u>: Gerald Mack updated the council on recent weed and tall grass complaints in addition to a couple of complaints regarding a domesticated turkey causing a disturbance at night.

- Solid Waste Disposal Agreement: Council reviewed the amended Solid Waste Disposal
  Agreement between the City of Troy and the City of Moscow regarding the tipping fee increase
  from 1.5% annually to 2.5%. After a brief discussion, councilwoman Cindy Gray made a motion
  to approve the amended agreement. It was seconded by Councilman Patrick Cordova. Motion
  passed by a roll call vote all in favor (Gray, Abbott Cordova). Motion carried.
- **Strom Electric:** Council reviewed the bid estimate from Strom Electric to install outside outlets at City Hall. After a brief discussion, the topic was tabled till the next meeting with the request to source other bids for price comparison.
