- **PUBLIC HEARING – AVISTA/Troy Electric Franchise Agreement** : Council to hold a public hearing for the purpose of hearing public comments and testimony regarding adopting **Ord. 2026-03: An ordinance granting Avista corporation, d/b/a Avista Utilities, a Washington corporation, its successors and assigns, the nonexclusive right, privilege, authority and franchise to locate, construct, install, own, operate, maintain, repair, and replace poles, elevated and underground wires, cables and appurtenances for the transmission, control and distribution of electricity within the city.**
