1. Pre-Commercial thin 20.86 acres. Acquire Bids late spring 2022. Last PCT project in 2020 had an average Cost of \$191.03 per acre.
2. Broadcast spray 50 acres for planting site prep. Estimated costs will be approximately \$5500.00. Actual planting happens in spring 2023. Planting cost of 15,000 seedlings will be \$3,750.00. The seedlings will need to be paid for in 2022. Cost of these seedlings will be \$9,000.00.
3. Need to get property along Dutch Flat Road cruised so we can get a handle on existing volume. This will also get eyes on what the forest health is looking like. **(Previously approved as shown in the attached minutes from 05/27/20)**
4. Propose to have 20% of the 1200-acre mountain property cruised each year. This would be approximately 240 acres each year. Cost would amount to approximately \$2000 to \$2700 annually
5. Proceed with additional timber sales as long as markets are good. Still many acres that need commercially thinned in order to enhance forest health.
