- **Ordinance No. 2026-02 Public Hearing:** Council to hold a public hearing for the purpose of hearing public comments and testimony, and to explain the reasons for such action concerning the following:
 - ✓ **Ordinance No. 2026-02** – An ordinance of the City of Troy, Latah County, State of Idaho, amending Title 9 of the Troy City Code; providing updated land use regulations; adopting legislative findings; and providing for an effective date. The general intent of the ordinance is to transition from the interim ordinance to a permanent amendment that reflects the City’s updated planning objectives, protects the integrity of the Central Business District, and ensures that land-use regulations remain consistent, predictable, and aligned with the City’s vision for future development.
