



**MEETING CALLED TO ORDER:** Mayor Corr called the meeting to order at 5:02 P.M.

**MINUTES:** Councilwoman Cindy Gray moved to approve the minutes from **06/22/22** and **06/29/22**. It was seconded by Councilman Mike Yenney. ***Motion carried.***

**CLAIM APPROVALS:** Councilwoman Cindy Gray moved to approve the claims/bills presented for July 2022. It was seconded by Councilman Mike Yenney. ***Motion carried.***

**MAINTENANCE REPORT:** Dale Howe updated on the new Wastewater permit and discussed the seepage test that needs to be conducted in the next couple of months per DEQ requirements for the estimated cost of \$11,000 from GPI, which requires council approval. In addition, he reported on recent vandalism to the Park Bathrooms and the need to have them temporarily closed. He added that a better security system needs to be implemented in order to prevent future occurrences. It was also requested by the Troy Arts Council that they obtain a key to the bathrooms to use during rehearsal times and to allow them to have a member park their camper at the park while the production set is being built to prevent set vandalism. After a brief discussion, the council agreed to the request from the Troy Arts Council and Councilwoman Cindy Gray further made a motion to also approve a quote from GPI for seepage testing up to the amount of \$15,000. It was seconded by Councilman Mike Yenney. ***Motion Carried.***

**FOREST MANAGEMENT REPORT:** Rich Schaefer was present to give a forestry report and discuss the recent incident of illegal dumping of roofing material on City Property at Tamarack Road. The incident is currently under investigation by the Latah Sheriffs' department and City resident Patrick Brandt has been diligently helping gather evidence from the site. Once all evidence is collected and with approval from the Sheriff's Department, the materials can be removed. Mr. Schaefer also gave an update on current timber prices and discussed the pruning of the white pine trees to help prevent Blister Rust. Additionally, he updated on certain areas that need harvesting but approval would be requested at a future meeting.
