Farmers Market: Council reviewed proposed changes by Erika Sattler to the draft contract agreement from Latah Farmers Market. After a brief discussion, council agreed to incorporate the requested changes into the contract for final approval at the next meeting.

Sanitation Services: Tim Davis (Sanitation Manager/City of Moscow) and Amanda Bashaw (Solid Waste Coordinator/City of Moscow) were present to discuss the City's sanitation services provided by both Latah Sanitation and the City of Moscow and answer questions/concerns from the council.

Solid Waste Disposal Agreement: Change regarding the proposed amended City of Moscow and City of Troy Solid Waste Disposal Agreement dated February 22, 2017, regarding an adjustment to Tire Disposal Fees was discussed. Mr. Davis informed the City that the contract is a formality since it was a change to a pricing schedule in the original agreement and that the fee will not affect residents directly unless they are disposing of tires at the transfer station or bulky waste sites in person. After discussion, Councilwoman Cindy Gray made a motion to approve the tire disposal fee modification and revised exhibit A with a retroactive date effective October 1, 2021. It was seconded by Councilman Bill Abbott. Motion passed by a roll call vote all in favor (Gray, Cordova, Yenney, Abbott). ***Motion carried.***



Parking: Council discussed City parking regulations and current parking codes/ordinances. Sheriff Richie Skiles was present to provide input and advice on the topic. It was agreed that current city parking codes need to be modified/amended in the near future and in the meantime city clerk Sabrina Moyer would be looking into codes and regulations from other surrounding cities for assistance in the modification process.

Daryl Power: Troy resident Daryl Power was present to inform the council of a shop light that has been shining into his house at night time and requested it to be tilted in a different direction as it was disrupting his sleep.
